



1. Why should I fund vaccination of my employees?

- In the UK an average of 600 people die per year from complications of seasonal flu
- 4.8 million lost working days annually in the UK due to Flu
- Studies indicate a significant proportion average 3.6 - 5.9 days per episode
- Equates to £644 million annual impact on the UK economy
- Flu causes loss of productivity even after employees return to work
- Increasing vaccination rates could significantly reduce the number of influenza cases and, consequently, lost working days. For example, a 10% increase in vaccination rates could potentially reduce infections by 40%, leading to 1.9 million fewer lost working days.
